Dear Dairy Beef Feeder Exhibitors,

The Hardin County Fair Dairy Beef Committee has made the decision to cancel the dairy beef feeder weigh in originally slated for May 30th. While a drive-through tagging was considered, it was determined social distancing guidelines could not be followed. The event was cancelled to protect volunteers, exhibitors, and the staff of the fair veterinarian's office. To supplement, exhibitors will need to have their dairy beef animals dehorned, surgically castrated and vaccinated with a vaccine covering BVD, IBR, BRSV and P13 by June 15th. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to make all necessary with the fair veterinarian's office. A receipt will serve as proof and must be submitted either by online form found at [hardincountyfair.org/coronavirus](http://hardincountyfair.org/coronavirus) or to the Secretary's Office by June 19th at 4pm.
